THINKING ABOUT COMMUNION: Do you want eternal life? Stand up! Where ever you are now: STAND UP! If people around you see you stand suddenly with phone in hand watching this video... tell them why! If people ask and you don't want to tell them about Jesus...sit down and hide your face! Now think... you'll never have to see them again, maybe also not see them later in heaven! *We are surrounded by a cloud of witnesses* (Heb.12:1)! They stood for Someone! If you recently sat back down, now again stand up for Jesus! True faith in Jesus believes and stands for something! Faith doesn't quietly hide! Loudly, sinners were against Jesus, yes all of us, our sin killed Him. He quietly died to save us! On the third day, Jesus stood up, giving life...your life & the life of that person watching you stand again and again for life. When Jesus comes, His judgement will happen like the sheep & goats story (Matt. 25:31-46)! The Sheep are people with faith. The goats are people with no faith! Notice that God praises faith's actions, serving that person standing with you. That one is Jesus standing there. When you help & serve them, you're standing to support those who can't stand for themselves... including the unborn's life! In the Lord's supper, goats don't see Jesus' true Body & Blood serving them! Notice Jesus' judgement (1 Cor. 11:27-29)! But Jesus meets your faith here at the Lord's Table! You receive His true Body and true Blood. Jesus forgives you! Jesus stands with & in your heart! He sees you here, now standing in that cloud of eternal witnesses! WOW!
